### **Recommended accommodation:**

In Barcelona there's a great offer of hotels and other accommodation, if you want to contribute to reduce the environmental impact of your visit, consider booking a hotel with an environmental certification or eco-label.

We suggest you an EMAS registered Hotel in Barcelona, actually we are organizing there the meeting:

Please, take into account that during spring Barcelona is very busy so, it's a good idea to book the hotel in advance.

### **Tax on stays on tourism establishments in Catalonia**

Since November 2012 there's a new tax on stays in tourism establishments similar to the one in other European cities. The tax is charged by the hotel and the invoice contains a separated breakdown of the amount paid. If you choose the Hotel Alimara, the tax will be of 1,21 € per person/night and it is not included in the above mentioned special tariff.

### **To and from the airport**

An eco-friendly and cheap way to travel from Barcelona's airport to downtown is by bus. The "Aerobus" leaves from Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 every 5' and it costs 5,90 € (one way) and 10,20 € (round trip). It takes about 35' from the airport to Plaza Catalunya. From Terminal 2 a train service is also available.

### **Public transportation in Barcelona**

Barcelona has an extended and efficient public transport network, have a look to this link: <http://bit.ly/1wZEF7P>

Barcelona has an integrated fare system enabling passengers to obtain a free transfer from one means of public transport to another within a period of 1 hour and 15 minutes. There are different types of travel cards and transport passes in Barcelona that are valid throughout the public transport network (metro, buses, tram and suburban rail).

A single ticket costs 2,15 €, this is an individual non-integrated ticket, so it's valid only for a single journey. If you are staying different days in the city consider buying:

- a T-10 card which is valid for 10 journeys and can be shared among more than one person. The T-10 card costs 9,95 €),
- or day passes available for 2, 3, 4 and 5 days. You'll find the tariffs and conditions here: <http://www.tmb.cat/en/barcelona-travel-card>

If you need a taxi, consider the option to book one of the hybrid taxis available in the city, you'll contribute to a better air quality in the city and a more efficient mobility of Barcelona.
